Dear Friends,

We urgently need your help this year! The most at-risk children in our community rely heavily on nonprofit support to ensure their needs are met; and their needs have risen sharply over this past year. The CASA Celebration event is CASA's largest annual fundraiser, the proceeds of which sustains our programs and CASA's ability to make a life altering difference to children in foster care.

In 2020, CASA advocates remained committed during the COVID crisis. Our organization trained additional volunteer advocates to meet the overwhelming demand of children entering foster care. Children weren't in front of teachers, coaches, and other supportive adults who typically identify signs of abuse and neglect at earlier stages. As such, during COVID, there was a dramatic increase in the number of children being referred to the foster system by hospitals and law enforcement, at which point the instances of abuse were far more extreme and disturbing. During a time when many nonprofits were cutting programs and scaling back expenses, CASA staffing grew in order to properly serve the children precisely when they needed it most, and ensure the advocates were properly trained, screened, and supported. Our goal is to ensure that our at risk children have someone checking in on them, making a connection, and supporting them through their trauma.

CASA volunteers are instrumental in helping a child feel supported. They are with them in their court hearings, they help navigate the education system, and offer mentorship which strengthens their foundation. Studies have demonstrated that children who have experienced abuse and neglect are at a significantly higher risk for academic failure, addiction, adult criminal behavior, and homelessness. But research shows that the most powerful antidote to the effects of childhood trauma is the presence of a reliable, stable, consistent adult in their life. This is what CASA provides and it is only through the generosity of you: our amazing supporters, that this work is possible.






THE PROBLEM:

- There are over 3,450 children and young adults in the Orange County foster care system - which is overburdened and underfunded
- The average judge handles more than 800 cases per year; the average social worker carries up to 40 cases at one time, and attorneys may have over 100 cases at any moment
- 1 in 5 former foster youth will become homeless within one year of leaving the system
- Only 58% of foster youth will graduate from high school
- Over 70% of the prison population is made up of people who were at one time in foster care
- By the age of 24, more than 50% of former foster youth will be unemployed





SINCE 1985...

- CASA-OC has recruited and trained over 3,825 volunteers who have served as Court Appointed Special Advocates
- CASA-OC has served over 8,000 youth in the foster care system
- 1.75 million hours volunteered by CASAs

THE SOLUTION:

- CASA volunteers provide the hope, inspiration and guidance that foster children need to successfully overcome their abusive past and achieve a positive future
- CASA volunteers go through 30 hours of comprehensive training, background checks, and an interview before becoming a sworn-in Court Appointed Special Advocate
- A child with a CASA volunteer is less likely to change placements
- Foster youth with a CASA have a 92% likelihood of graduating from high school
- Over 65,000 volunteer hours will be devoted to children in 2021 saving nearly \$1.9 million in costs to the community
- More than 800 children in the OC foster care system will be served in 2021
